Key Details

Botanical name: Raphanus raphanistrum
subsp. sativus

Maturity from sowing: 38-50 days

Foliage: Strong, healthy tops

Harvest: At 20 cm

This variety will increase in length if allowed to stand.

Market segment: Fresh use as with globe radishes, soups, stir fries, bunching and salad packs.

Taste: Milder than red rounds.

Planting season: Ideal as a cool season crop, planting from late summer until winter. For summer plantings insure adequate soil moisture and reduce plant population. Require early harvest to avoid bolting.

Root Characteristics

Tuber size: 25-35 cm long x 4-4.5 cm wide

Skin: White and smooth
